Twice During Week End

Even with the accurate shooting of Tom Firestone, who scored 31 points, Leesburg handed the Jackets the 11th loss of the season Friday as the Jackets went down in defeat 73-69.

Syracuse got a quick start and stayed ahead in the first quarter 16-13. Early in the second quarter Leesburg came back and held an 8 point lead until Tom Firestone started finding the mark scoring 16 points during the quarter.

Syracuse was ahead at half-time 41-31. Leesburg came back with a 31 point third quarter and left the Jackets behind 62-54 at the end of the period.
