Easter COLORING CONTEST

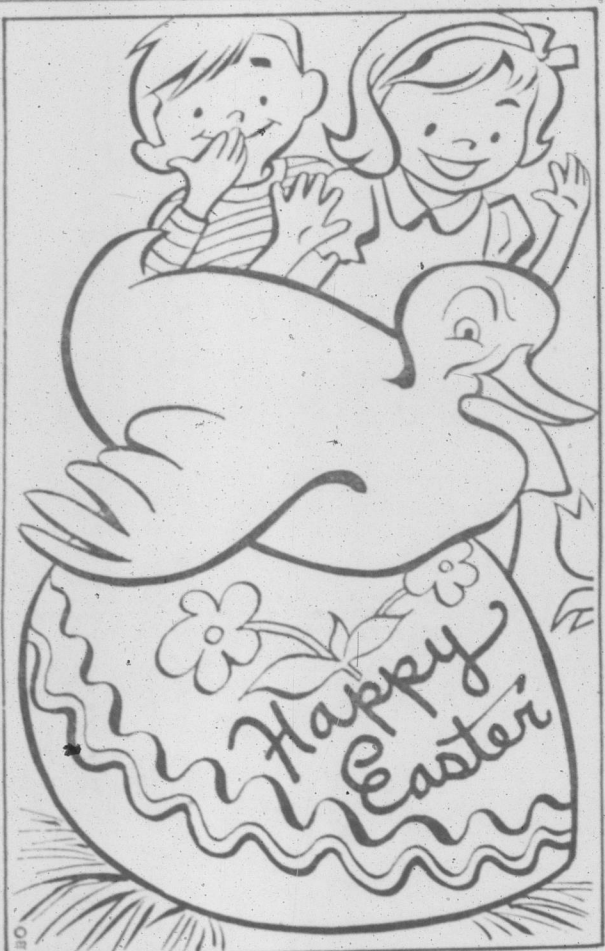
